在我們天主教的信念中,除了天堂和地獄外,我們相信有一個中間的境界----煉獄,煉獄是煉靈進入天堂前停留並煉淨的處所。我們知道天主是至聖至潔無瑕的神體,但我們人類活在世上的受造物,往往修德未凑完美,帶有瑕疵,因此在我們完全回歸至美至善的天主前,我們需要一個煉淨的過程。這過程就是"煉獄"。再說清楚一點,煉獄是人去世了,但在愛主愛人方面,未凑圓滿!因而未能與至善至美的天主完全结合。

#### 在煉獄中的特點就是:

1.人靈已肯定得救,他遲早會升天堂,與天主完全結合,永遠享受祂的聖愛! 2.但在煉獄中的人靈,不能自助,他們需要天上諸聖及在世信友的友愛援助:為他們獻彌撒,行哀矜,克苦,祈禱及作各種的善行等等。

天主真是愛人的真神! 祂不但造生我們人類,更讓天主聖子耶穌,甘願被釘十字架上,為我們贖罪; 祂的大愛還不止於此: 當我們生活於世,修行和愛心未湊完善時,天主於此也不放棄我們,祂安排了一個煉淨的地方------我們所稱的"煉獄",讓所有離世而尚有礙疵的人,在煉獄裡等待,讓天上聖者和在世的善人,為他們獻彌撒,行善功,拜苦路…。

煉獄的道理是真的嗎?應該是真的! 因為它有聖經的根據: 請看瑪加伯書下第十二章,它提及猶太人在一次戰役中,有許多兵士戰死了。但在收斂陣亡者的屍體時,發現亡者內衣,藏着偶像的符。於是衆人一同哀禱,求天主使他們所犯罪過,得以完全赦免…。衆人同時募捐了二千両銀子,送到耶路撒冷作贖罪祭的獻儀 (vv. 40-43)。

我們知道基督教弟兄不談煉獄。他們相信教徒離世後是在主內安息,並等待末世的審判 及復活。由此我們亦可推知,為何基督教沒有封立聖人聖女的傳統。天主教相信"諸聖 相通功"同時相信煉靈在淨化過程中,不能為自己立功贖罪。只能依靠親朋好友的祈祷 和犧牲。其中尤其有效的是彌撒聖祭,因為效果來自基督自己的功勞!所以有超凡的價 值!

天主教的煉獄觀,包括三個單位 (1) 天上的得勝教會。(2) 地上的戰鬥教會。(3) 煉獄中的受苦教會。三個單位同屬一個團體-----即基督奧體。因此基督體內的血液和营養,是可以交流互通的。這些血液和营養,就是: 恩寵,功勞及相愛相屬的關係。

這種血液和營養,在<煉靈的奇妙秘密>這本小書中表達得淋漓盡致。記得當我在四間大學和 CASS 的同學在一起時,一天一位纽修戚大學的女生遞給我一本油印的小書,是上述的題,我接過馬上閱讀,感覺內容很有意思,我差不多一口氣把它讀完,然後衝動地要籌款把它印刷。教會內愛惜好書而願意捐獻的人不少!短時間內,我已能把這小書派發給會看中文的大學生及教友。由於內容真實有趣,又簡短,向我取閱的人很多。之後我多次重印,同時派給悉尼的各華人團體。其後又加印英文版,派給四間大學的同學。

這小書告訴我們煉靈的真實故事。值得推介及閱讀。

## **Month of the Souls in Purgatory**

In our Catholic faith, we believe that in between heaven and hell there is an intermediary state – the Purgatory, where souls are purified before entering into heaven. God is most holy but we as His created beings often live a life of imperfectness and full of blemish. That is why before we enter into eternity in union with God who is all good and all perfect, the souls must go through a purification process, the Purgatory. Simply speaking, Purgatory is the state where the souls of the departed have not reached perfection in their love of God and love of people, so they are not yet ready to be in union with the all good and all perfect God.

What is so special about Purgatory is that:

- 1. The salvation of the soul is assured, it is a matter of time that the soul will enter into heaven and be in union with God, to be in His eternal love forever.
- 2. The souls in Purgatory are helpless, they need the saints in heaven and the faithfuls on earth to offer Masses, penance, intercession, charitable and corporal works of mercy for them.

Our God is a God who truly loves mankind, not only has He created us, He also sends His son Jesus to offer His life on the cross to redeem us from our sins. His love does not stop there: even though we lived a life short of perfection in love and virtues, He does not give up on us. He has a place of purification --- the Purgatory, to let the departed souls receive the help they need from the heavenly saints and the faithfuls on earth, as they offer Masses and the merits in good works and the Stations of the Cross for the souls.

Is the teaching on Purgatory true? It is true because it is based on the Bible! In 2 Maccabees 12 it is mentioned that there was a battle in which many Jews died, when Judas and his companions went to gather up the bodies, they found under the tunic of each of the deceased amulets dedicated to the idols. Together they prayed to God that the sinful deed of the deceased may be completely forgiven. Further a collection of two thousand silver drachmas was taken and sent to Jerusalem to provide for a sin offering (v 40-43).

Our protestant brothers do not talk about purgatory. Their teaching is that the souls of the departed believers will rest in God's presence awaiting the final judgement and the resurrection. Also they do not have the tradition of canonisation of the saints. Our Catholic faith believes in the communion of saints and that the souls in the Purgatory, while in the process of purification are no longer able to do penance for their own sins, but have to rely on the prayers and supplications of their loved ones on earth. Among those the most effective way is to offer Masses on their behalf, since the merits being offered are from Christ Himself and hence carry exceeding and surpassing value!

The Catholic view of the Church is made up of three parts (1) in heaven the Church triumphant (2) on earth the Church militant (3) in purgatory the Church suffering. All three are in communion and belong to the same mystical body of Christ. The nourishment and blood circulation flow through to each part of the same body. These nourishments are: the grace of God, merits of charitable works and the loving relationship between one another.

The connectivity and flow of such nourishment is expressed most insightfully in the booklet "The Amazing Secret of the Souls in Purgatory". I remembered during the time when I was with the CASS students across the four universities, one day a female student from UNSW handed me the booklet. I started reading it immediately. I found the content very meaningful and almost finished reading it in one go. Right afterwards I had this impulse to raise fund for printing and distributing copies to other people. Truly there are many people in the church willing to donate for the sake of good books! Within a short period of time I was able to hand out copies to the students and the faithfuls in our community who can read Chinese. Given that the content of the book is not lengthy and really interesting, a lot of people began to ask me for a copy. I reprinted the booklets many times and distributed it to other Chinese Catholic communities in Sydney. Later on an English version was also printed and copies given out to the students in the four universities.

The booklet tells us the true story of the souls in the Purgatory, it is highly recommended and worth reading.
